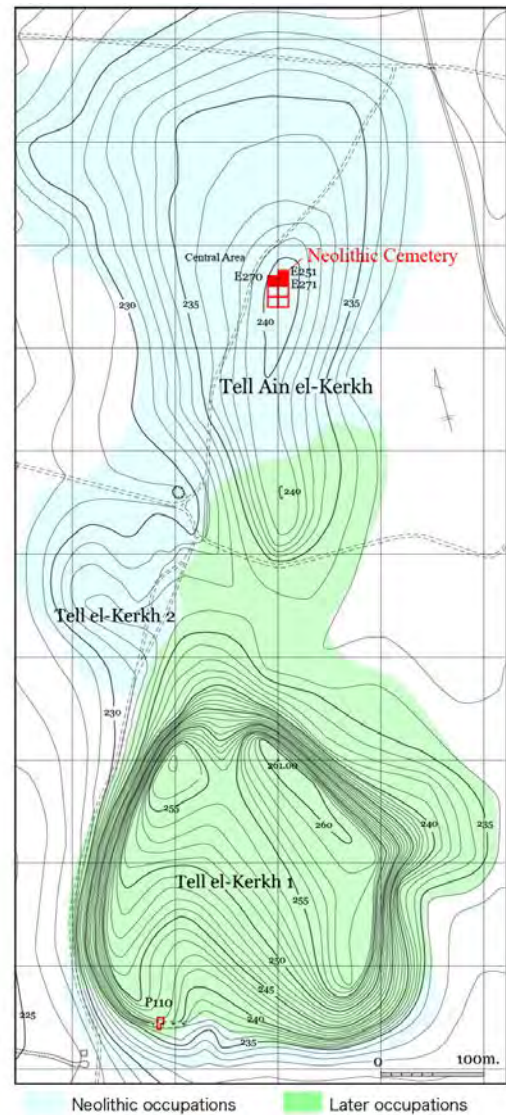


Figure 3-2 Map of Tell el-Kerkh

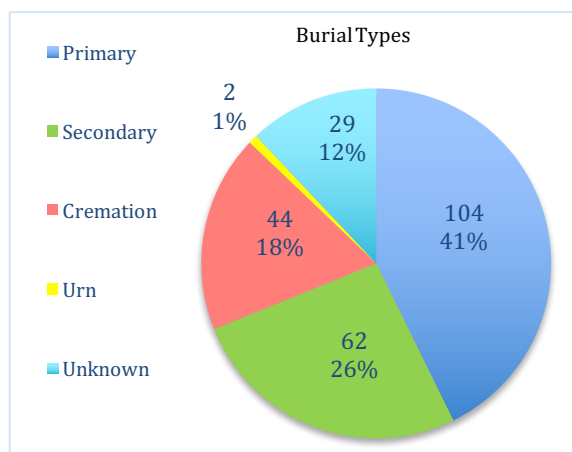


Figure 3-3 Burial types in Kerkh cemetery

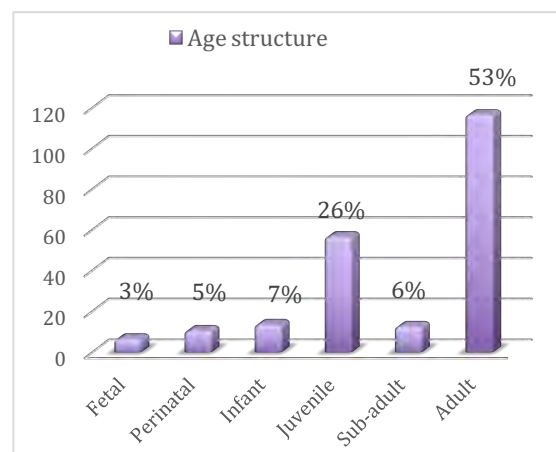


Figure 3-4 Kerkh cemetery age structure

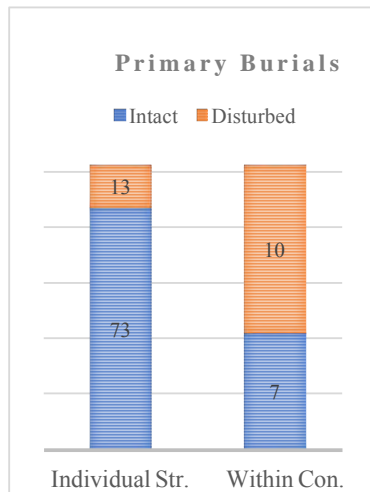


Figure 3-5 Primary burials condition

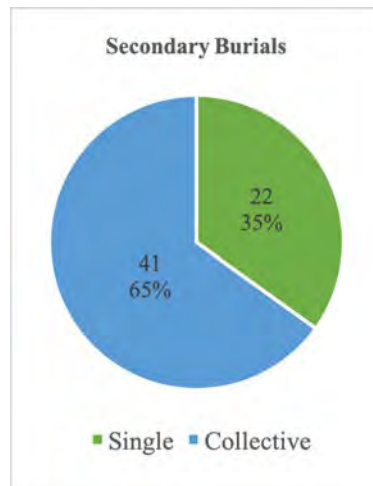


Figure 3-6 Secondary burials

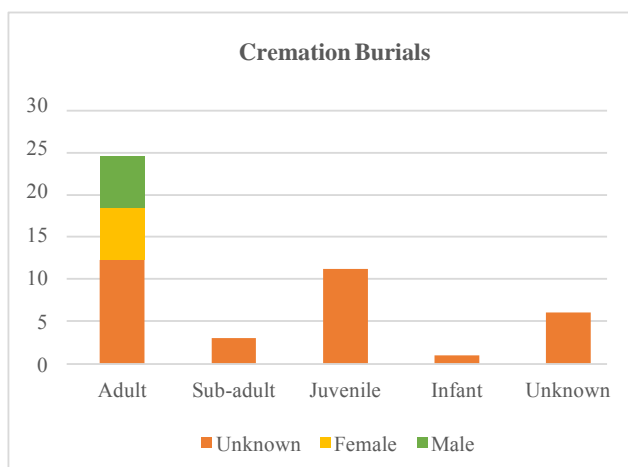


Figure 3-7 Cremated individuals age structure

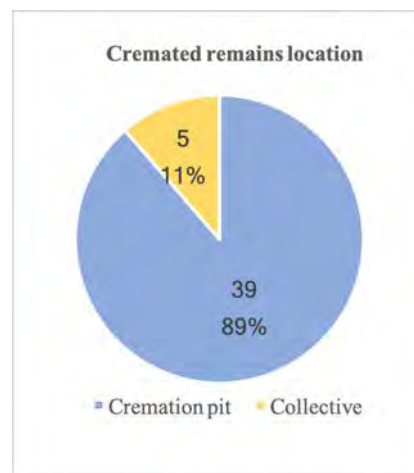


Figure 3-8 Cremated remains location

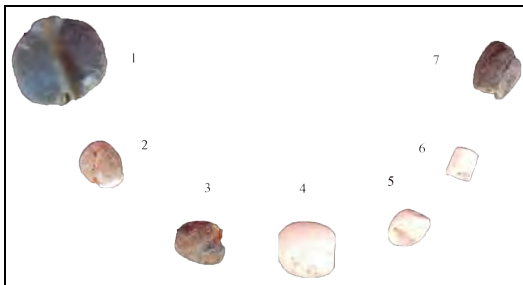


Figure 3-35 Str. 739, grave goods

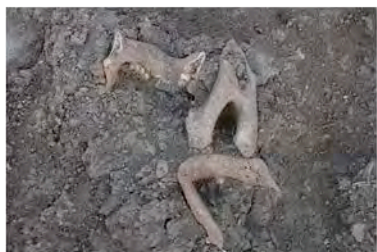

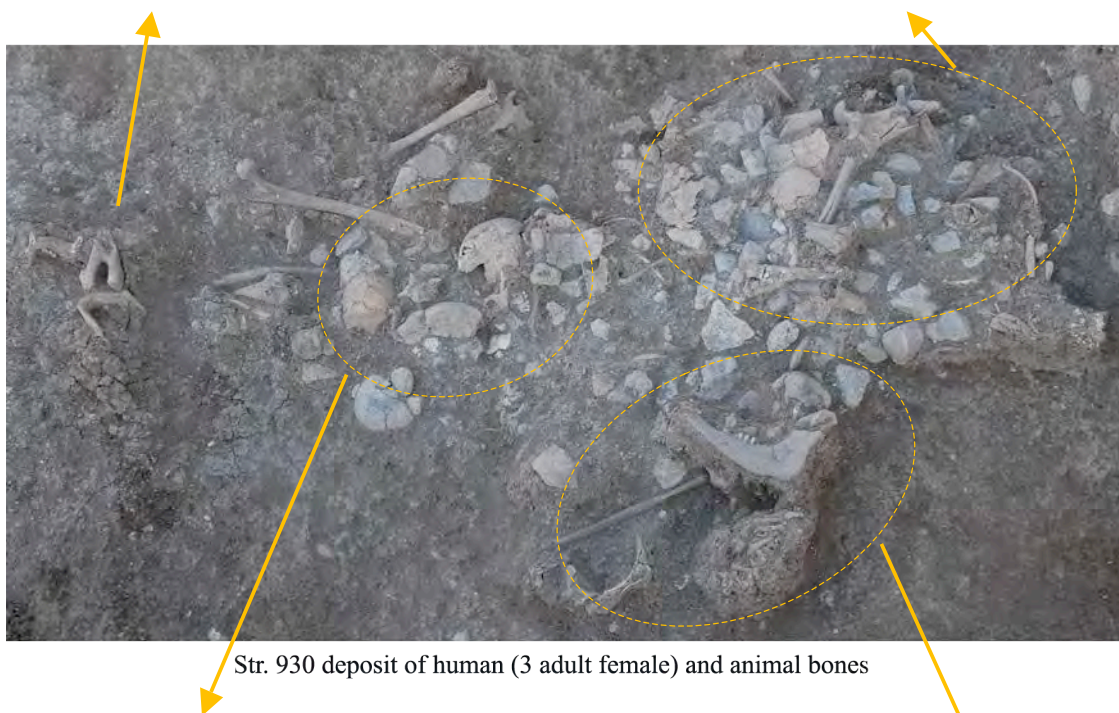

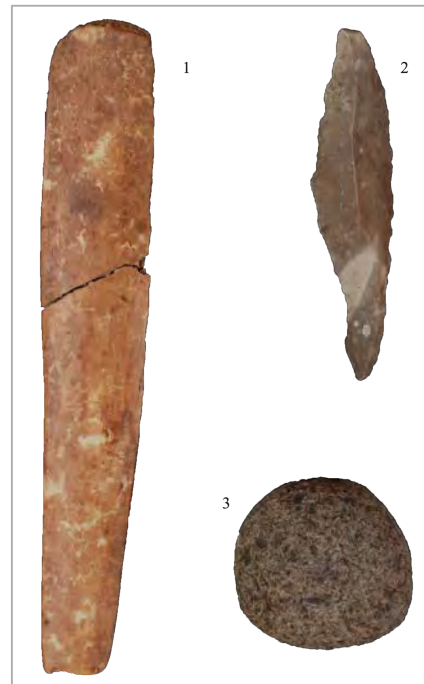


Figure 3-90 Str. 941, grave goods

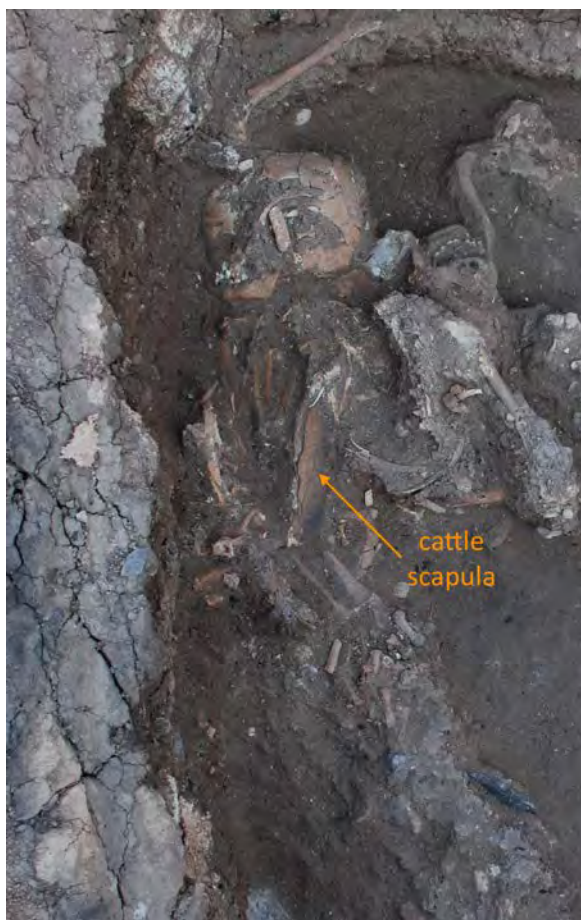


Figure 3-97 Str. 985, a 6-7 yrs. old juvenile

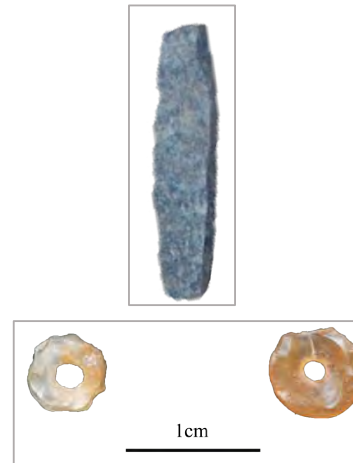


Figure 3-110 Str. 1056, grave goods

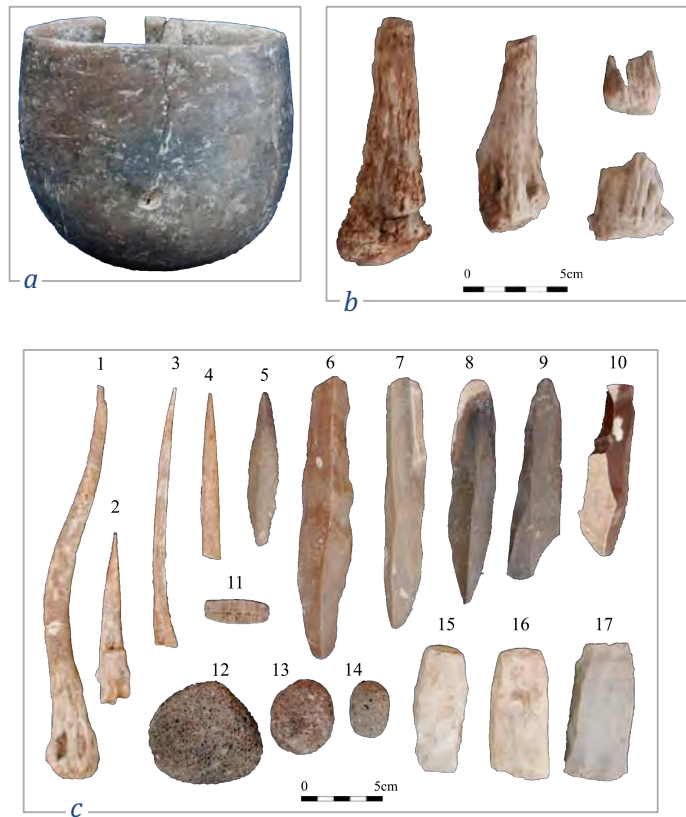


Figure 3-113 Str. 1058, grave goods

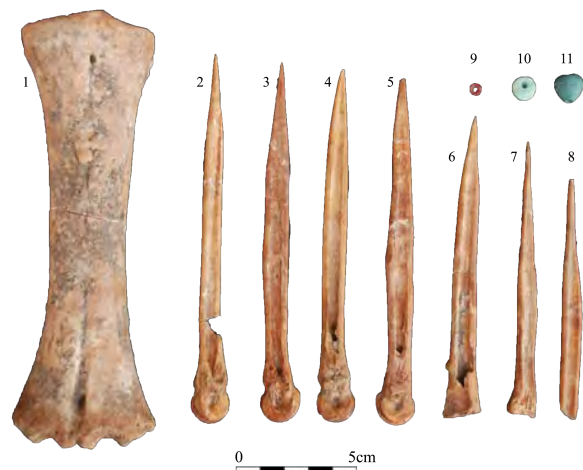


Figure 3-131 Str. 1081, grave goods

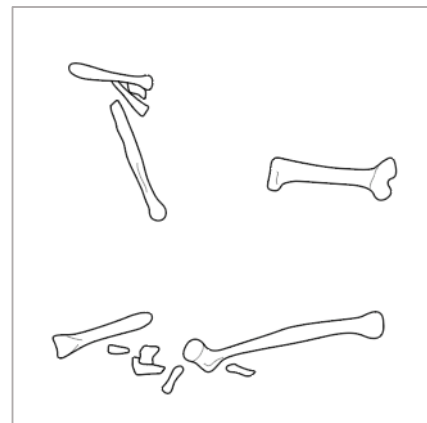


Figure 3-133 Str. 1083, dismembered long bones

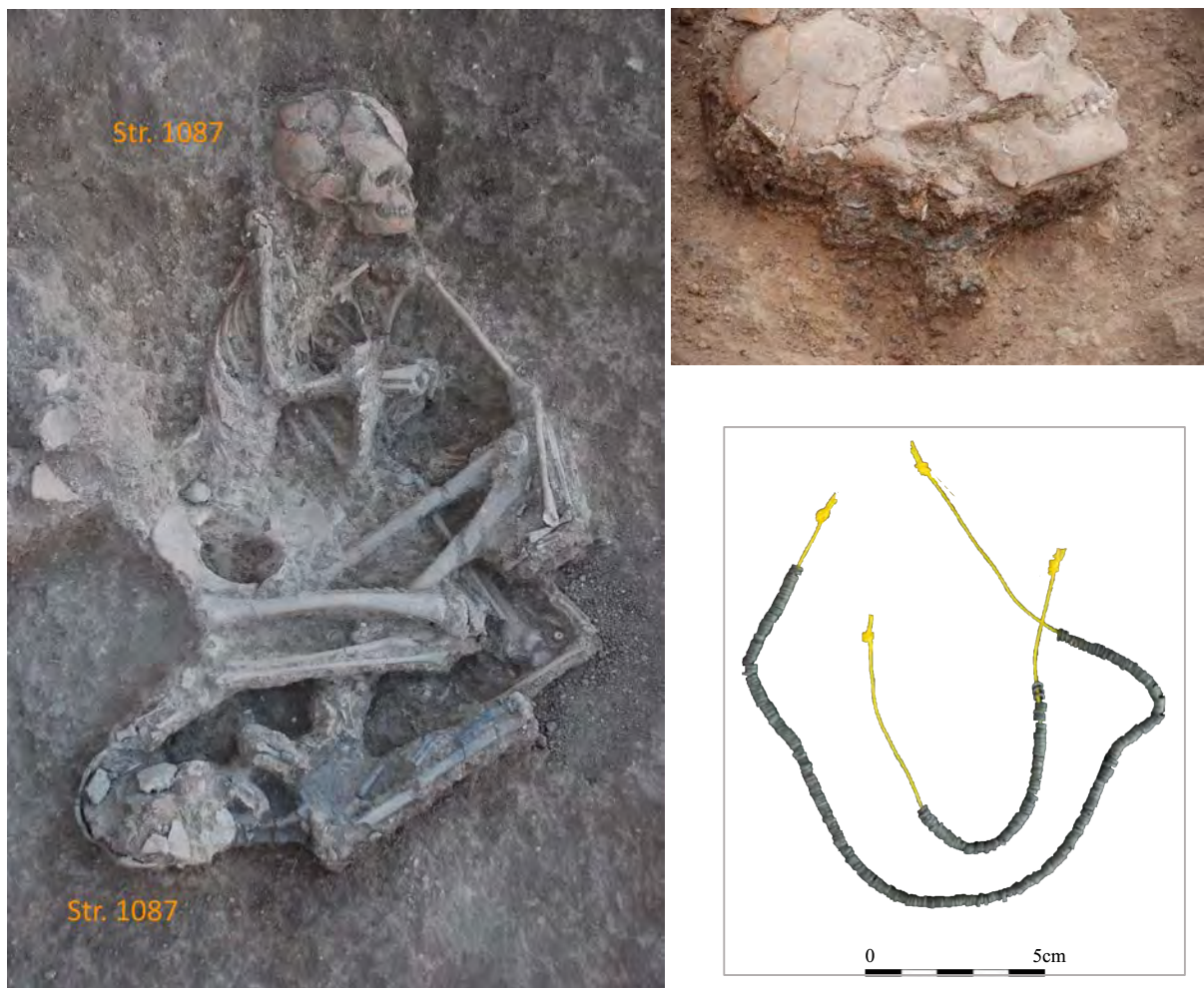


Figure 3-138 Str. 1087, a young adult, probable female

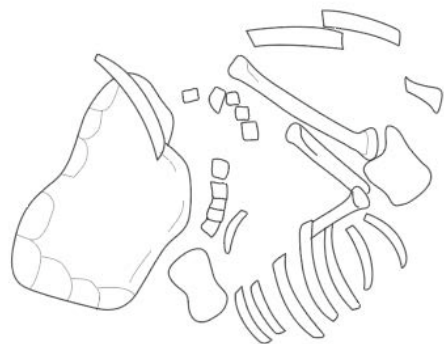


Figure 3-150 Str. 1098, a perinatal
